This small exhibition at Thrust Projects in Chinatown brings together four local artists who are linked by their cultural heritage and mutual admiration for the Brazilian artist Hélio Oiticica (1937 – 1980). The exhibition's organizer and participant Johanna Unzueta titled this show after a saying coined by Oiticica: "Seja marginal, seja herói" (be marginal, be a hero). Although the premise for

the exhibition is slightly vague, it successfully facilitates a dialogue between the works of each artist, while allowing them room to express the influences of their individual backgrounds.






Chilean artist's Cristóbal Lehyt's oil on aluminum paintings present varied imagery of the culture and landscapes of his homeland. The video by Spaniard Itziar Okariz depicts the artist performing several variations of the irrintzi, the traditional Basque shrill to indicate a joyous moment. Unzueta, a Chilean, exhibits three of her hand-sewn felt sculptures that mimic industrial objects such as a pipe and a wheel barrel.

Finally, fusing the disparate works in the gallery is the scattered wall drawing by Felipe Mujica from Chile, who also presents drawings of geometric patterns derived from old Chilean posters. Deeply personal, these works portray the artists' solid connection to their origins, as well as the underlying inspiration that is embodied here in Oiticica's persona.
